Fee for Service Therapist Job Description

Position Summary

At MCM Collaborative therapists provide therapeutic services across modalities such as individual, relationship and group, within credential scope of practice and as appropriate to therapists' skills. Everyone's clinical voice is their own, but as a therapist in our practice, therapists will uphold practice values and provide care that is anti-oppressive, strengths-based and trauma-informed. Therapists will also engage in clearly defined specialized projects that further the practice's mission and values.

Responsibilities

- Maintain a caseload of at minimum 15 clients
- Provide competent, clinically appropriate psychotherapy
- Integrate Anti-Racist and Trauma Informed principles in all work
- Complete administrative tasks such as progress notes and billing submission
- Communicate directly with clients about payment fees, scheduling and attendance
- Engage in individual and group supervision
- Participate in MCM Collaborative professional development and continued learning opportunities
- Based upon therapist's interest, skill and capacity—identify, develop and complete specialized projects, providing regular updates on progress of projects
- Maintain proper licensure (including meeting continuing education and other requirements)
- Participate in the promotion of MCM Collaborative, PLLC services including being listed on practice websites and other relevant sites, publications, etc.
- Comply with practice policy and procedures
- Complete other tasks as mutually agreed upon

Required qualifications

- Minimum 1 year Post Masters experience providing direct psychotherapy services
- Deep knowledge, competency and care in serving the BIPOC and LGBTQIAA+ communities
- MSW, MHC and other mental health degrees from an accredited graduate program
- New York State licensure applicable to degree

Compensation/Benefits

- \$50/session for individuals, \$55/session for Couples/Partnership, \$60/Group
- 2 weeks PTO
- Weekly individual and group supervision
- Company provided Professional Liability Insurance
- Eligibility for transition to full time employment after 6 months
